

Barsyl signs pact with UK firm to provide signal design work

Barsyl, a rail consultancy and engineering company has signed a pact with DEG Signal Ltd of the UK to provide consulting services in railway signalling.

The Hyderabad-based firm has been executing multi-disciplinary rail contracts in India and about 15 countries abroad on projects involving freight, metro, monorail and high speed rail systems, said Sunil Srivastava, Managing Director. DEG Signal, based in Wiltshire, UK, is into railway signalling and design. The two will initially share specialist resources to deliver rail design work to the UK and later expand.
